About the kiwi trademark


The iconic Kiwi trademark is licensed to businesses by the Buy New Zealand Made Campaign.

The trademark signifies that a product or service is New Zealand Made according to the rules of the Fair Trading Act. As a registered trademark, it has a strict set of rules (Code of Practice) governing how it can be used.

Re-established in 1988, this trademark is used as a significant marketing tool for businesses. When products carry the registered Kiwi trademark customers can be confident that the country of origin is New Zealand.

The New Zealand Kiwi trademark is a label, a sticker, a logo and a brand. This guide will help you to use it correctly and get noticed by consumers.

Why use the kiwi trademark?

The Kiwi trademark is a trusted brand that is globally recognised as a label depicting NZ Made products.

Why label with country of origin?

87% of New Zealanders recognise the iconic Kiwi trademark75% of global consumers list brand origin as a key purchasing driver64% of Kiwis buy locally produced and grown products over imported ones

Quick start summary

Now that you've been inspired by the different ways the Kiwi trademark can communicate your market origin advantage, get started by completing the following.

- 1. Order your product labelling by choosing from either stickers or swing tags or download the artwork and integrate it into your packaging design.
- 2. Decide whether to label on the front or back of your product as Factual Product Branding or Product Certification respectively. If you want to do something unique with the Kiwi trademark consider creating something different that is truly unique using Embedded Product Branding option. The Buy NZ Made team will review and approve proposals.
- 3. Overlay the Kiwi trademark on your social media posts and website as Watermark Branding with the help of a web or social media agency.
- 4. Create recognisable Signage Branding that your audience is likely to see with the help of a signwriting company.
- 5. Get some Team Branding up in your workshop or office so that your team are proud of what they're making.



Modern New Zealand Made triangle



The modern soft-edged triangle was launched in 2013.

The iconic black logo is the go-to for a majority of NZ Made licence holders.



It is important to have clear space around the logo to provide sufficient prominence. The exclusion zone is equivalent to the height of the 'NZ' in the Buy New Zealand Made name, as shown here.

Alternative logos



This is a secondary logo that can be used if a colour version is preferable. In 2022, the campaign decided licence holders can choose any colour for the logo to match their branding.



The black and white triangle is the primary logo. The classic blue and red triangle can also be selected if the blue and red colour palette is more effective to use on your products. In 2020, we also launched the white triangle logo. This great to use where the black is too harsh.

New Zealand Grown



The New Zealand Grown green triangle can be used to help New Zealand growers get compliant with the Country of Origin Food Labelling Act.






Logo misuse

Yes - there is artwork for a rectangle Kiwi trademark available in your dashboard.








In A Circle Instead of a Triangle
